Note that there is a second tab to this document which is the burn rate calculator. Remember the “what, so what, now what” when your POC is responding to this.

This does not replace the data calls that your State Health is working with Paul Link, HHS, on, in regards to the five key data points on: total medical/hospital beds; total acute care (ICU) beds; normal hospital occupancy; predicted surge occupancy; and number of ventilators available in your state.
