Re: Anthem Claims Payment Delays

Dear Commissioner White:

Several of our hospital and health system members have recently made us aware of significant claims payment delays by Anthem Health Plans of Virginia, Inc. The uncharacteristic volume and consistency of these various reports compels us to contact the Bureau of Insurance (BOI) for awareness and follow-up.

Va. Code § 38.2-3417.15(B.1) requires that carriers pay clean claims within 40 days of receipt of the claim. We have been told of high volumes of hospital claims that are now aged past the 40-day mark; and some more than 90 days past the submission date. Without access to privileged contractual or reimbursement information, we do not know the exact financial impact of this issue. However, we estimate the amount past due to Virginia hospitals is cumulatively in the *hundreds of millions of dollars*. This is cash flow hospitals expect and need to fund ongoing health care operations.
